This meeting is organized jointly by the Department of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine CCM / CVK at Charité-Universitätsmedizin Berlin and Teladoc Health.

At the **Charité**, we are pioneers in critical care telemedicine. Acting as a 24/7 referral center to intensive care units across the German capital and neighboring federal states.

With the ERIC project we implemented evidence-based telemedical consultations as a tool to improve patient outcomes.

Teladoc Health uses its virtual care expertise in critical care settings, connecting hospitals with tele-ICUs. Through secure video and data platforms, on-site medical teams can collaborate seamlessly with remote experts, enabling enhanced patient monitoring, timely consultations for complex cases, and support for critical decision-making.

Together, Charité and Teladoc have worked together to bring evidence-based medicine to patients across multiple countries, including Ukraine, South Africa, Montenegro and Uzbekistan.

Recently, a living lab was established between Teladoc and Charité to explore the clinical and technical opportunities of telemedicine.
